OUTCOME TO PARTICIPATE IN REAL-WORLD INTEROPERABILITY DEMONSTRATIONS AT HIMSS 2009

The HIMSS Interoperability Showcase allows us to demonstrate our interoperability technology and our commitment to providing real-world interoperability solutions," said Dan Levy. Participation at the IHE Connectathon is required to qualify for participation in the Interoperability Showcase at the HIMSS annual conference.
